Knitted garments such as T-shirts, sweatshirts, jackets, pants, nightwear, underwear and babywear, made of white, yarn- & piece-dyed 100% cotton (incl. recycled cotton) or mixture with elastane & polyester (incl. recycled polyester), pigment or non-PVC printed (incl. fluorescent), discharge printed on cotton and cotton/elastane only; White and piece-dyed 100 % viscose, viscose/elastane, cotton/modal, cotton/modal/elastane, viscose (bamboo)/cotton (also pigment printed), cotton/polyester (also in brushed) and viscose/elastane (also reactive digital printed). Melange knitted garments made of 100 % cotton, cotton /viscose, cotton/PES and mix with Elastane, printed (pigment, discharge, non PVC on cotton and cotton/elastane only); reactive dyed melange made of 100% cotton (incl. recycled cotton) or mixture with elastane and polyester (incl. recycled polyester), pigment or non-PVC printed (incl. fluorescent). Including accessories: sewing threads, buttons, zippers, drawstrings, elastics, metal accessories and printed and woven labels. Based on pre-certified materials according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
